Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors
January 17, 2006

Atty. Schwane-Update of proposed legislation

Atty. Schwane stated that there was an initial meeting on January 11, 2006 with Robert Dahn, Atty. Kevin Reynolds and Senator Colapietro to discuss the content of proposed legislation and to make a point that there was no controversy. Mr. Dahn stated that the members of the initial meeting were cautiously optimistic; since there was no opposition from Senator Colapietro and that, he suggested that this should

be introduced as either a bill or an amendment that could not be amended. This means

that the proposed legislation would not run the risk of being introduced and having some other bill tacked on to it that was controversial. This meeting resulted in another meeting with Representative Christopher Stone scheduled for January 24, 2006 in order to defend the content and to smooth the path to get the proposed legislation introduced. It was suggested that the chairperson or a few board members appear at the January 24, 2006 to help address any questions regarding content of the proposed legislation.

F-Complaints

F-1 Proposed Agreement Containing Order of Immediate Discontinuance-Docket No. 05-1697 (Dist. 2).

Respondent is a limited liability company, where the principal has an engineering background and has been approved to sit for the professional engineer exam. The limited liability company was using the term engineering. The order of immediate discontinuance states: that the respondent shall immediately discontinue from practicing or offering to practice the profession of engineering, or using any title or description tending to convey the impression that it practices or offers to practice engineering, unless it has obtained a certificate of registration from the Board.

Motion made by (8) seconded by (2) to accept the proposed agreement containing the order of immediate discontinuance. Motion carried.

G-Other Items

Joel Fisch, whose Connecticut license lapsed on 1/31/90 and was advised of the reinstatement process posed a question to the Board as to whether or not it would be acceptable for someone to re-take Parts I & II of the PE licensing examination in lieu of “reinstating” a lapsed license by having to pay all back fees.

The Board held a discussion and determined that the Board may waive the exams under the current statutes for reinstatement, but the Board’s counsel advised the Board that it does not have the authority to waive the reinstatement fees. Atty. Peter Huntsman stated that he will check further and report to the Board at their next meeting.

Motion made by (8) and seconded by (5) to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
